

Corn Cob



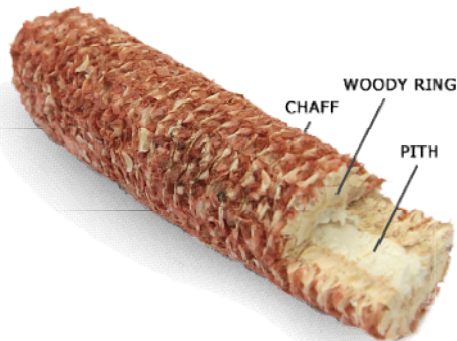
Corn Cob is a granular media, but because of its low Moh hardness, it generally does not leave an anchor pattern. This makes the cob grit ideal for cleaning dirt, grease, and oil on delicate surfaces. Uses include cleaning log cabin timbers, removing smoke damage, polishing brass, cleaning and degreasing motors, generators, transformers and insulators.

Common Sizes: 10/14, 14/20, 20/40, and 40/60

MOH's Hardness: 2.5-3.5 Average MOHS

The Magic of Corn Cob

The Corn Cob has both Absorbent and Abrasive Properties. The Chaff is on the outside, the Pith is the soft spongy center, and the tough Woody Ring is in between. The Chaff and the Pith provide Absorbency while the Woody Ring has the major Abrasive properties.
