

Coal Slag



Coal Slag is a relatively fast cutting angular media that provides surfaces with ideal anchor patterns. Typical usages include the removal of heavy rust, tank linings, mill scale and most thick coatings. Coal Slag's are used on ships, barges, bridges, tanks and etc. It is not considered a recyclable abrasive, but it offsets the lack of recycles with its low purchase cost.

Common Sizes: 10/40, 12/40, 20/40, 30/60

MOH's Hardness: 6.0-7.5 Average MOHS
